

UMPIRES COURSES AT TAUNTON & WESTON SUPER-MARE

The cost of the course is £70, but any club umpire (see above for criteria), will receive a subsidy of £35 from the SCL providing that the form is counter signed by the Chairman or Secretary of the Club to indicate that the applicant is a bona fide person wishing to umpire club matches and not solely interested in obtaining the certification. There is a limited number of subsidised places on these courses and early application is therefore advised as a ‘first come first served’ policy will be used.
