# Minutes of the Management Committee Meeting held on Wednesday September 10 2014 at the Shrubbery Hotel, Ilminster

Those present Malcolm Fox, Ian Latchem, Toby Strang, Tom Packman, Amanda Counsell, Edward Martin, Matthew Lunn, Matthew Counsell, David Derrick and Ray Hancock.

- 1. Preliminaries. The Chairman welcomed all Committee members to the meeting.
- 2. Apologies were received from Martin King and Derek Hicks.
- 3. The Minutes of the previous Management Committee Meeting (August 27 2014) were approved.
- 4. Matters arising. The Committee agreed to bring forward a rule addition that supported Minute 19 whereby a player arriving late can participate fully in the game from the time he enters the field of play.
- 5. Correspondence. An email had been received from Watchet CC (Chairman) complaining about a fines deduction and the process adopted. The Hon. Secretary's reply was also tabled. The Committee considered all the evidence and found the complaint to be out of order, incorrect in content and lacked any real understanding of the way the SCL operates. The Chairman, Malcolm Fox agreed to respond to the second email and make it abundantly clear that the system operated by the administrators of the SCL over the past 40 years would continue. He also noted that the Watchet CC's club details page on the website had not been updated since January 24 2013! This is contrary to the directives issued to all clubs earlier in the season.
- 6. The Committee agreed to support an initiative started in Gloucestershire to help club umpires (and players who also umpire) to have a better knowledge and understanding of the laws of the game. The Committee would investigate this at a future meeting and be prepared to fund parts of any Somerset initiative.
- 7. The Hon. Treasurer said that a set of final accounts would be produced at the next meeting. He was currently sending out invoices for next season's subscriptions, fines issued this season, which also included an item due for late cancellations (£30 fine under rule 3 (i)).
- 8. The Committee noted the Don Crouch scores (sportsmanship) and expressed its concern over some teams with low marks. The Committee recommended that the tables be published (Appendix A) with the minutes and requested that the club committees of the low scoring clubs take careful note of the statistics and ensure that the sportsmanship factor be addressed before next season. The Committee debated a penalty points' fine for clubs that failed to achieve a particular level and this will be discussed further at the next meeting in order to put a rule addition to the AGM. The likely system would involve a 'Don Crouch' points' review after 8 games, followed by a warning to teams that failed to reach the specified threshold and then a further review after 16 games to gauge if a significant improvement had taken place. Teams that failed to show an improvement would be fined 15 points. Furthermore, a 'minimal points' target' would be set at the start of the season for clubs to meet if they were to claim any of the monthly 'Team of the Month' awards. The Hon. Secretary was pleased to report that there had been no major disciplinary issues during the season, other than fines for technical offences.
- 9. The Committee was advised that the WEPL board had met and determined promotion and relegation issues. The WEPL Chairman had requested that North Perrott 1. & Ashbrittle be promoted to Tier 4 (Somerset Division) and that Winscombe 1. be relegated from Tier 4 to the SCL Division 1. The Hon. Secretary said that Chris Norton also asked if it was possible to accommodate Glastonbury 2<sup>nd</sup> XI in the SCL although the 1<sup>st</sup> XI would remain in WEPL (Tier 3), while at the same time allow Wembdon 2<sup>nd</sup> XI to remain in Tier 3 (2<sup>nd</sup> XI competition) even though Wembdon 1<sup>st</sup> XI was returning to WEPL Tier 4 (Somerset Division). The Hon. Secretary said that he was able to help in this rather different 'end of season' movement providing that he

could establish an agreement for WEPL & SCL to work from identical fixture matrices and agree the numbers allocated to Glastonbury and Wembdon. The Hon. Secretary agreed to contact Chris Pannell on his return from holiday.

- 10. The Committee confirmed the final tables for 2014 that were shown at the meeting. It agreed that these should be published with these minutes. (Appendix B).
- 11. The Committee determined the winners of the various trophies awarded by the Committee. a). The Ladbrokes Merit Trophy for the Club of the Year was awarded to Banwell & Churchill b). Broadway & Horton 2<sup>nd</sup> XI and Taunton St. Andrews B XI shared The Don Crouch Memorial Trophy with a maximum average score of 10 marks. It was noted that 2 other teams (Wells 2 and Chard 750) recorded a maximum score of 10, but both teams had cancelled a number of games during the season due to their inability to raise a team. The Committee felt that this disqualified them from the competition. c). Sunday Independent Cup was won by Evercreech with the highest number of points (536 Pts.) scored in any division.
- 12. The Committee noted that the Results Service had worked well again this year and most clubs had little difficulty in operating it. However, the system will be changed in 2015. The monitors will continue to monitor, record and check results on the website and issue fines, but the paper copy will no longer be required by Ian Latchem, the Results Secretary. David Derrick and John Squirrell will investigate the possibility of the system self-checking the points and making the operation of inputting the result and the scorecard as a simultaneous action. The Hon. Secretary will look at his needs in relation to the Club Details Sheets and discuss with the website manager how the website can provide him with all the necessary facts through a single input in the Club details section on the website. Meanwhile, all player stats will be archived at the end of September followed soon after by the removal of ALL 2014 player registrations and the club details/email addresses sections. In due course, the Hon. Secretary will advise clubs of the range of information and timescale required for the inputting of the 2015 club details and email addresses.
- 13. The Committee members noted that there had been only one reported problem with the standard cricket ball and as a result the SCL would continue to place its cricket ball order with Lords International in 2015.
- 14. The Committee discussed the issue of ground standards that were provided by some clubs and were concerned about the lack of basic facilities at some of them. Toby Strang, Chairman of the Grounds Committee provided a list of clubs that would be circulated to ascertain their future intentions, together with a letter that would be emailed to them. The letter and clubs are shown in Appendix C.
- 15. Regionalisation. The Committee noted that the survey of divisions 5, 6 and 7 clubs plus three possible entries into those leagues showed that 10 teams favoured regionalisation, 13 were opposed to it and 10 made no response to the survey. The Committee determined that regionalisation would not be used in Divisions 6 & 7.
- 16. Promotion, relegation and composition of divisions for 2015. The Committee considered the document outlining the proposed promotions, relegations, 2015 composition and the regionalisation of divisions 8 & 9 that had been prepared by the Hon. Secretary. The proposed format was agreed and is shown in Appendix D. It was also agreed that any club that withdraws a team after the 'cut off' date of September 30<sup>th</sup> 2014 will be fined £100. This will help compensate for the additional administration costs involved in re-writing fixtures etc.
- 17. The Committee discussed some possible rule changes/additions. a) Two new balls per match b) Last time for starting a game to be moved from 5.00 to 4.00 pm. c) A rule to allow more discussion, agreement and possible travelling when weather conditions cause cancellations. d) 40 over games for all divisions or divisions 5 9. e) The use of a transfer form. f) Revision of Rules 3 f, g; Rule 5(j) iii; Rule 7 (b) to reflect adjustments to the club details/emails, results procedure and transfers. No exact proposals were made, but the items will be discussed at the next committee meeting in October. The Committee encouraged clubs that wish to put forward their own rule changes to do so as soon as possible but no later than October 12<sup>th</sup>.

- 18. The Hon. Secretary gave details of the Presentation Night which will take place at the Shrubbery Hotel on Friday October 24. The principal guest will be Steve Kirby of the SCCC. Tickets, which are available from the Hon. Secretary are again priced at £18.
- 19. The Hon. Secretary said that the fixtures for 2015 would be made as soon as the exact composition of the League can be ascertained. A similar matrix to that used last year will be used again this year to reflect the mixture of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> XIs within the same competition. The fixtures are likely to be circulated to all clubs soon after October 12.
- 20. The Committee nominated three members (namely Amanda Counsell, Matt Lunn and Martin King) who had served their 3 year term for re-election to the Management Committee at the AGM in November.
- 21. The date of the next meeting was confirmed for Tuesday October 14<sup>th</sup> at 7.30 pm. at the Centre of Excellence, County Ground, Taunton.
- 22. The meeting closed at 10.15 pm.

Dear Club Representative,

The Management Committee has agreed that the Grounds Sub-Committee should make recommendations in advance of the 2015 Season and these to be maintained for future seasons. The Somerset Cricket League has determined that certain minimal conditions <u>must</u> be in place in order that Clubs can meet the following basic ground requirements and provision of facilities. In particular, this directive applies to some club's second pitches and must be available for committee inspection before the commencement of the next cricket season:-

- 1. Toilet provisions are made available close to the playing area.
- 2. Proper shelter for players during inclement weather. (A suitably sized gazebo for instance).
- 3. A sufficient number of chairs and a scorer's table.
- 4. A fully stocked 1<sup>st</sup> aid kit as detailed in the pre-season circular.
- 5. Changing and showering facilities in the adjacent main ground for players and umpires.

We appreciate only too well that you use a school ground, but very much feel that the above requirements are achievable.

The Grounds Sub-Committee will make ground visits to view that these basic conditions listed above have been established.

Failure to have these facilities in place will be notified to the Management Committee for their rulings of how we proceed.

I look forward to receiving your club's acceptance and valued efforts to facilitate these requirements.

## Meeting of The SCL – Management Committee – September 18 2013 *Minute 14*

The Committee discussed the ground standards that clubs should be providing for cricket in the future. The minimum acceptable standard should be adjacent toilet provision (within 50 metres of boundary), proper shelter for players during inclement weather, chairs, a scorer's table and a fully stocked I<sup>st</sup> aid kit as detailed in the pre-season circular. In relation to these minimum acceptable standards the Committee discussed the promotion of Bridgwater 'A' to Division 1. The Ground Committee had met the officials of BCC and agreed that these minimum standards should be in place for next season. It was agreed that the Hon. Secretary should write to BCC and obtain from the club a written guarantee that these facilities/equipment will be in place two weeks prior to the commencement of the season. Failure to make this provision by April 19 2014 would result in any home matches being null and void and the -30/+35 point scenario would apply. However, the representatives of the Ground Committee wished to put on record the fact the officials of BCC had been most helpful and reassuring on the occasion of the site visit and the Committee members anticipated that the measures outlined above would be in place.
