THE STANDARD LEAGUE CRICKET BALL

The Committee has confirmed that the Crusader Sports ball that has been used during recent seasons will again be used **for Season 2010**. The balls will again be stamped with the League's name and the Sponsors name and logo.

The Price for Season 2010 will remain the same at £7.50 per ball.

If problems with the balls arise then the League will replace them and take up the complaint with the supplier.

Clubs will receive the balls at the Captains' Meeting that will be held as an Extraordinary General Meeting in April 2010. Clubs will be invoiced prior to this meeting **and will need to bring their cheques for the balls to this meeting. Please do not send any money for the balls now. The Treasurer will invoice clubs for balls and insurance in the New Year and clubs should then send the payment to the Treasurer or bring to the EGM.**

I have printed a list of the clubs below and against the club name I have put the number of balls that I have ordered for your club. Please check this list and advise me by completing the return form at the bottom of the list **ONLY if you require extra cricket balls**. You must order additional balls in multiples of 6 (ie. a box). The latest time that you can order extra balls is **MONDAY January 18 2010**.

I have calculated your ball order on the following basis:-

- 1 Team = 12 balls
- 1 Team in Div. I = 18 balls
- 1 Team in Div. 1 + 1 Team = 30 balls
- 1 Team in Div.1 + 2 other teams = 36 balls
- 2 Teams = 18 balls
- 3 Teams = 30 balls

Note. Although some clubs may only require 9 or 27 balls they must have the next higher multiple of 6 to avoid splitting a box.

The calculation is based on Division 1 teams needing 18 balls per season (2 per game) and all other teams needing 9 balls per season. **If non-Division 1 clubs decide to use more than one ball per game or order more balls for general club use, then the opportunity exists to buy extra balls at the advantageous special price of £7.50 by completing the ball order form.**

The Committee encourages clubs to consider using two new balls per game to provide a fairer contest and hopes that this special price will aid clubs to make that positive decision.
