

Club Usernames and Passwords

Club Unique Username and Password.

The Somerset Cricket League has recently invested in a new system to keep its administrative system up to date and allow the League officials to keep in regular communication with all the appropriate personnel in the individual clubs.

A username and password have been devised for each club. These codes should be used to access the club page and keep the club personnel details and email addresses up to date.

The Chairman has expressed the view that the Somerset Cricket League is now one of the best administered cricket leagues around and he is determined to keep it in the forefront of cricket leagues in the future. He is keen to see this electronic administrative system working properly after the League's expenditure in installing it. He has ruled that clubs that do not keep the 'Communication System' up to date will be fined for letting the League down and compromising the value of it to clubs and others who access the pages on the website. It will also mean that club contacts may not receive communications if they fail to ensure that their addresses and tel. numbers are up dated whenever there is a change of details of any listed person or a replacement made.

All clubs need to ensure that they access their site between now (April 26) and May 31 2009 to check that their records are completely correct and up-date them accordingly. The Hon. Secretary has access to the whole system and can see the exact time and date that a club page was last opened – even if there are no changes made!

The League Officers of the Management Committee have ruled that any club failing to check their club details, and bring them up to date as necessary will be fined £30 after the first check (just after May 31) and £30 on subsequent checks after a warning has been issued. [See Rule 10 Other. (a)].
