We are writing to inform you of two courses in the SCB Coach Education Programme for 2009/2010. Can you please circulate this application form to members within your club and assist us in finding both suitable and committed candidates for our Coach Education courses.

Please find specific details of our 2009/2010 Coach Education Programme along with a generic reply slip. Reply slips will be accepted from all affiliated clubs in Somerset. **Please encourage your prospective coaches to take up these places and progress your club's junior section.**

Please Note: Clubs will be allocated a maximum of up to 3 candidate places per course unless the course is not fully subscribed.

**The next course of the programme is a UKCC1 course to be held at Writhlington on October 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> 2009. The Assessment Day for the course will be on Saturday October 17<sup>th</sup> and the 1<sup>st</sup> Aid and Child protection elements will be held on Sunday October 18<sup>th</sup>.**

**The following course of the programme is a UKCC2 course to be held at Withywood Merchants Hall on November 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> 2009 and the 1<sup>st</sup> Aid and Child protection elements will be held on Sunday November 22<sup>nd</sup>.**

Additional information for prospective UKCC2 Candidates.

Details of supported practice should be completed as per the reply slip. The programme should cover six x 30 minute sessions with a UKCC2 or above qualified coach, to be completed after the course modules but prior to the assessment date. Further details of supported practice are available from your Club Coach Education representative, the ECB website or by contacting the SCB Development Team at the Centre of Excellence. For all courses, candidates will be required to produce evidence of, or undertake the ECB CRB Verification Process before they can be certificated.

The Somerset Cricket Board payment policy is to encourage prompt payment and also to ensure that as many candidates as possible complete their course, details are as follows:

UKCC1 – Total cost of the course - £200-00.

Cheque made payable to “SCB” from candidate for £125-00.

Cheque made payable to “SCB” from club for £75-00.

UKCC2 – Total cost of the course - £250-00.

Cheque made payable to “SCB” from candidate for £125-00.

Cheque made payable to “SCB” from club for £125-00.

You will be required to complete the 1<sup>st</sup> Aid and Child Protection Courses as part of your qualification, unless you can provide photocopied evidence of a current certificate (please enclose this with your reply slip). Places can be reserved for these courses by completing the relevant section of the reply slip. A cheque made payable to the “SCB” will be required from the candidate for £20-00 for each additional qualification.

**The Somerset Cricket Board will be subsidising the cost of each course by £125-00 per candidate. This will be reimbursed by the SCB directly back to the candidate after completing the course, assessment and certification.**

Once again, may we remind you to return your reply slips and appropriate payment **As soon as possible**. Allocation of places will be made on a ‘first come, first served basis’.
