The Shrubbery Hotel - Somerset Cricket League

Minutes of the Management Committee Meeting held on Tuesday September 6 2016 at Centre of Excellence, County Ground, Taunton.

Those present Malcolm Fox, Tom Packman, Derek Hicks, Amanda Counsell, Toby Strang, Matthew Lunn, Andy Fairbairn, David Derrick and Ray Hancock.

- 1. Preliminaries. The Chairman welcomed all Committee members to the meeting.
- 2. Apologies were received from Martin King, Ian Latchem, Matthew Counsell and Edward Martin.
- 3. The Minutes of the previous Management Committee Meeting (June 29 2016) were approved.
- 4. Matters arising. There were none.
- 5. Correspondence There were two items that the Committee considered at this stage:- a) A letter from a long standing umpire/club official who expressed his concern about the behaviour and language used by some cricketers. It was noted that the Hon. Secretary had responded to the letter and explained that if the officials could identify the culprits and the comments, the League's Disciplinary Committee would take action. The Hon. Secretary said that it was the League's policy to try to eradicate bad behaviour from the SCL scene and any incidents needed to be reported to the Disciplinary Secretary Edward Martin. b) The Team of the Month for July had resulted in a tie with both Trull 2 and Minehead 1 recording 175 from 5 matches at an average of 35 points. The Chairman conducted a draw and Minehead 1 was declared the winner of the July Team of the Month. The Team of the Month prize for August/September produced very close scores and even closer averages.

- c) A number of other emails and letters had been received and forwarded to committee members. These would be considered at the appropriate place in the meeting.
- 6. The Hon. Treasurer said that the accounts showed a better picture than had been expected due to less expenditure on the umpires and the selling of cricket balls from stock. Fines, yet to be confirmed, were likely to be higher than budgeted. A more detailed set of accounts will be presented at the next meeting.
- 7. It was noted that the Don Crouch scores (sportsmanship) were generally higher than previous years. One club only had slipped below the 80% line. The Disciplinary Secretary, who had made a very positive contribution to raising the standards, would be in contact with the club upon his return. The tables showing the complete set of Don Crouch scores are attached as Appendix A. The team with the best score was Taunton Deane Crusaders with an average of 99.38%. Taunton Deane Crusaders has been awarded the Don Crouch Trophy.
- 8. The Disciplinary Committee had met on a couple of occasions, but generally disciplinary issues were at a minimum.
- 9. The details of the WEPL league tables were shown to the Committee and it was noted that Minehead 1 and Temple Cloud 1 will be promoted to WEPL (Somerset) for next season. Butleigh 1 and Frome 1 had been relegated from WEPL (Somerset) to the Premier Division of the SCL. The Hon. Secretary will be preparing the 2017 WEPL fixtures shortly and the SCL fixtures, which are dependent on the WEPL ones will follow. The SCL fixtures will be prepared in mid October.

- 10. The Committee confirmed the final tables for 2016 that were shown at the meeting. It agreed that these should be published with these minutes. (Appendix B). It was noted that one Division 9 fixture had been delayed until September 10 due to logistical reasons.
- 11. The Committee determined the winners of the various trophies awarded by the Committee. a). The Ladbrokes Merit Trophy for the Club of the Year was awarded to Trull Cricket Club. b). Taunton Deane Crusaders won the Don Crouch Memorial Trophy with a very good score of 99.38%. c) The Sunday Independent Cup was won by Trull 2nd XI with the highest number of points (563 Pts.) scored in any division.
- 12. The Committee noted that the Results Service had worked well again this year. However, there were a few anomalies in the details set out on pages 18 & 19 of the Handbook. It was agreed that the Hon. Secretary and the Assistant Secretary would review the process set out in the 'Instructions for On-line Submission of Results & Scorecard' in the handbook.
- 13. The Committee noted that it may be necessary to re-struct the lower divisions in order to meet the terms of Rule 1 The League, c) where the bottom 6 division must be regionalised.
- 14. Promotion, relegation and composition of divisions for 2017. The Committee considered the document outlining the proposed promotions, relegations and the 2017 composition that had been prepared by the Hon. Secretary. It noted that, as proposed and carried at the EGM in April 2015, regionalisation of the last six divisions was made for Season 2016 and will continue in 2017. The Committee decided that it could not confirm the composition for 2017 at this time as there was a number of outstanding issues with regard to the teams wishing to retain membership, the Flexi League and those which wished to join the SCL. The final decision on the composition will be made at the October Management Committee Meeting. It was noted that WEPL had agreed before the season 2016 commenced to a 'two up and two' down promotion/relegation between the "Top" division in the 4 feeder leagues and Tier 3 in WEPL.
- 15. The 'Flexi League' initiative was discussed and the responses received to date were analysed. However, it was not possible to take the proposal forward until after the 'flexi league reply deadline' of September 20. The possible establishment of a flexi league and the composition of the SCL teams in 2017 will be finalised after October 11.
- 16. The committee considered the voting process for rule changes/additions and was also reminded of the change to Rule 4. Alteration to Rules. This change, which was proposed and carried at the EGM, required only a simple majority of 1 to be effective. Furthermore, any proposals for rule change would need to be have been sent to clubs prior to an AGM/EGM. Clubs must then discuss the proposals, vote on the ballot sheets that are attached to the notice and deposit the ballot sheets in the SCL Ballot Box prior to the start of the meeting. The Committee considered that this process needed a complete overhaul to ensure that clubs were fully aware of the effect of any changes by informed debate; were able to participate in constructive discussion at league/club level and finally complete a 'secret ballot sheet that would be counted at the AGM/EGM. The Committee decided to explore this process at the next committee meeting and then issue a time table of meetings.
- 17. The Committee briefly discussed some possible rule changes/additions, but left the detailed discussion to a future meeting. The Committee encouraged clubs that wish to put forward their own rule changes to do so as soon as possible but no later than October 10th.
- 18. It was agreed that the standard cricket ball used in the 2016 season will be used again by all teams in 2017. The cost of the ball will be determined after discussion with the supplier.
- 19. Toby Strang, Chairman of the Grounds Committee said that the Committee a) had noted that one club was having major reconstruction to its facilities, but was hopeful that the renovations would be completed by the start of next season. b) would be expressing its concern and seeking an explanation over the state of a pitch that saw the team batting first dismissed for 24 runs and the game was over shortly afterwards.

- 20. The Hon. Secretary gave details of the Presentation Night which will take place at the Shrubbery Hotel on Friday October 21. The principal guest will be James Hildreth of the SCCC. James will present the trophies and join Richard Walsh in a question and answer session. Tickets, which are available from the Hon. Secretary, will again be priced at £18. He said that details of the function and the booking of tickets will be circulated at the same time as these minutes.
- 21. The Hon. Secretary said that the fixtures for 2017 would be made as soon as the exact composition of the League can be ascertained. (Any further withdrawals/additions must be made by October 3). A similar matrix to that used in 2017 will be used again this year to reflect the mixture of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th XIs within the same competition. The fixtures are likely to be circulated to all clubs sometime after October 15.
- 22. The Committee nominated three members (namely Ray Hancock, Edward Martin and Toby Strang) who had served their 3-year term for re-election to the Management Committee at the AGM. However, the Committee is still very keen to involve some younger members in the administration of the SCL. If there are any cricketers who would be prepared to join the Management Committee and help with moving cricket in the Somerset Cricket League forward, then the Committee suggests that they get in touch with the Hon. Secretary Ray Hancock.
- 23. Any other business. There was none.
- 24. The date of the next meeting was confirmed for Tuesday October 11th at 7.30 pm. at the Centre of Excellence, County Ground, Taunton.
- 25. The meeting closed at 9.50 pm.
