

Somerset Cricket League

Minutes of the Management Committee Meeting held on Tuesday October 11 2016 at the Centre of Excellence, County Ground, Taunton.

Those present Malcolm Fox (Chairman), Amanda Counsell, Matt Counsell, Tom Packman, Toby Strang, Andy Fairbairn and Ray Hancock.

- 1. Apologies were received from committee members Derek Hicks, Matthew Lunn, David Derrick, Edward Martin and Ian Latchem
- 2. The Minutes of the previous Management Committee Meeting (September 6 2016) were approved.
- 3. There were no matters arising from the previous minutes, other than those that related to items to be discussed later in the agenda.
- 4. Correspondence that had been received related to items in the agenda and would be discussed at the appropriate time.
- 5. Treasurer's Report. The Hon. Treasurer provided a written report that outlined the Income and Expenditure Account for the Year. The report showed a small deficit of £69.99. The report will be published with the AGM notice and agenda. The agreed one-year subsidy of SACO umpires had amounted to a total of £1410. Next year clubs receiving appointed umpires will be liable to the full normal SACO charge. He described the various facets of the income and expenditure account and answered members' questions.
- 6. Umpires and SACO. It was noted that a number of clubs (captains) in the Premier and 1st divisions had not submitted an 'umpires report' to SACO following a match. There was no penalty for this failure, but the Committee planned to introduce a fine in 2017. Andy Fairbairn said that the SCB plan to run a course "Introduction to Umpiring" in the close season at various venues in the county. SACO had indicated that it hoped to provide two umpires per match in the top two divisions of the SCL in 2017. Umpiring will be a topic on the next agenda.
- 7. The Hon. Secretary reported that the Presentation Night at the Shrubbery Hotel on Friday October 21st will be attended by approximately 120 players and guests. James Hildreth from Somerset County Cricket Club will be the principal guest and he will be joined in a question and answer session by Richard Walsh, Cricket Correspondent for the Somerset County Gazette and the Sunday Independent. James will then present the trophies to the divisional winners. A draw for cricket equipment, which has been given by Mr Najmi, Lords Cricket Balls, will take place during the evening.

- 8. The Committee noted that the clubs that won the 'Team of the Month' prizes had received a letter from Best Western with details of the prize and venues that had been allocated.
- 9. The Committee decided that as all nominations had not been presented, the AVCO Trust Young Player of the Year and the Glastonbury Mowers All Rounder's would be determined at a later date and presented at the AGM.
- **10.** Amanda Counsell, the League's Welfare Officer said that only a small number of club welfare officers needed to complete a refresher course in readiness for 2017, but as there was only one course planned for this Winter (November 23) at Clevedon CC she would bring the course to their attention. Any club and/or CWO who needs guidance should contact Amanda at the earliest opportunity rather than wait to the beginning of the next season. A full list of Welfare Officer courses is shown in Appendix A.
- 11. It was noted that the WEPL re-structuring process had been a successful initiative and at the end of the 2016 season Minehead and Temple Cloud had been promoted from the SCL (Premier Division) to the 3rd tier of WEPL, while Frome and Butleigh had moved in the reverse direction.
- 12. The Committee discussed the cricket balls used in 2016. The members were advised that the Hon. Secretary had received no complaints throughout the season. However, it was noted that balls, which are imported from Pakistan, could be considerably more expensive in the future due to the value of the \$.
- 13. The Committee discussed the voting process that had been used at the recent EGM in April. In order to allow member clubs' representatives, the opportunity to have a forum to discuss proposals for rule changes/additions, the Committee will be changing the structure of forthcoming meetings. It will initially hold a "Rules Meeting" in November and the AGM in December/January. The rules meeting will enable members to express the views of their clubs, but no voting will take place. At the AGM club representatives will return the 'ballot' papers, which will have been discussed and completed at club level. These ballot papers will have the proposal detailed and three boxes ("For"; "Against"; "Abstain") for the clubs to cast their vote on each proposal. The proposals will be sent to clubs in the same format as previously and in good time for debate before the rules meeting. The AGM with the proposals will be encouraged to attend the rules meeting, although there will be no fine for absence. However, the fine (£40) will still be applied to non-attenders at the AGM. It is hoped that there will also be a presentation by the SCB on a cricket related issue at the AGM. More details will be circulated later with the AGM documentation.
- 14. The Flexi League. The Hon. Secretary reported that 6 teams had indicated that they would like to participate in this new concept. Taunton Deane 5th XI; Weston super Mare 5th XI; Uphill Castle 4th XI; Shapwick & Polden 4th XI; Baltonsborough and Blagdon 2nd XI from the B & D league. It was agreed that a fixture list would be constructed based on the suggested criteria that was outlined in the initial flexi league documentation.
- 15. Final Tables 2017. The Committee confirmed the final divisional tables for season 2016 and these are shown in Appendix B
- 16. Composition of Divisions for 2017. The agreed composition is displayed in Appendix C at the end of these minutes. Due to the fact that the number of teams registered to play in the SCL in 2017 had dropped to 108, Division 6 would be regionalised. The divisions 1 5 would be county wide while divisions 6 8 would be regionalised north and south. The Committee was prepared to adjust these divisions if a team felt it was in the wrong division. Any club wishing to make a change MUST contact the Hon. Secretary by October 23 2016 after which time the fixtures would be made.

- 17. The Hon. Secretary said that he had started preparing the fixtures for 2017 and they would be published after October 25. Attention was drawn to the imbalance in divisions 8. It was agreed that due to travelling distances Div. 8S would be a full division of 10 teams, while Div.8N would comprise only 8 teams. The geographical layout for this arrangement is shown on a basic map of the county in Appendix D. The Hon. Secretary said that he would endeavour to make fixtures within Division 8N to give a full set of 18 games.
- 18. The Committee discussed some possible rule changes and agreed to put these into a 'Rules Format'. These would be published, together with any proposals from clubs. The publication of the proposals for rules changes would be circulated to all clubs by October 26 in time to give clubs 'sufficient discussion time before the Rules Meeting on Monday November 21 (the original AGM date). The AGM will then be held on Monday December 5. The publication of the official AGM notice and reports would be carried out by November 14 as per Rule 3 Administration 9 (c) General Meetings.
- 19. Toby Strang, Chairman of the Grounds Committee, said that a number of grounds that had been under scrutiny had shown improvements. He repeated the statement that the Grounds Sub-Committee would be keeping a careful watch on developments, particularly in the case of school/college facilities.
- 20. The meeting closed at 9.45 pm.
- 21. The dates of future meetings were confirmed as:-The Rules Meeting on Friday November 21st at the Shrubbery Hotel, Ilminster at 7.30 pm. The AGM on Monday December 5 at 7.30 pm. at the Shrubbery Hotel, Ilminster.
