To all contacts in the Somerset Cricket League.

1. Collection of cricket balls for Season 2019. You will recall that I gave advance notice of the Special Meeting of the membership of the SCL for the purpose of discussing items of pitch markings; circles; registrations and the collecting of cricket balls for this season.

I have now taken delivery of the cricket balls, which will be distributed on Monday April 8 at Wembdon Cricket Club, 'The Green at Wembdon', Homberg Way, Wembdon, Bridgwater. TA6 7BY as previously noted.

Clubs that fail to collect their cricket balls on April 8 will be fined £40 as per rule.

The Committee has now reviewed the distribution of the information regarding a) pitch marking, b) circles and c) registrations. It feels that the most appropriate means of giving out this information is through this circular and future circulars. Hence, some copies are attached.

However, the cricket balls still require distribution and clubs must make arrangements for the collection on **Monday April 8 at Wembdon C C**, or face the fine (£40) and collection at a later date and venue. Clubs may get together and help each other out by a joint collection. All clubs are reminded that a pre-payment by cheque or BACS must be made before April 8 or at the meeting. Provided that the balls are collected, fines will not be levied for non-attendance at the meeting.

3. New Rule regarding the marking of grounds with a 30 yard circle. This applies to ALL matches in Divisions 1-5.

The Rule states:- Rule 5 Matches (o) Premier Division to Division 5 Matches Only. At the instant of delivery a minimum of four fielders plus bowler and wicket keeper must be inside an area bounded by two semi circles centred on each middle stump within a radius of thirty yards and joined by parallel lines on each side of the pitch.

This fielding circle shall be marked with painted white dots at five yard intervals — each dot can be covered by a white plastic or rubber disc or in white marking measuring seven inches in diameter. Should this requirement not be met then the square leg umpire shall call and signal no ball and the delivery must be redelivered; this condition must be met regardless of the total number of fielders present (e.g. if a side has less than eleven players present).
